While we are all looking forward to the day it is safe to gather with friends for lunch at the Lopez Senior Center, the San Juan County Meals on Wheels Program is busier than ever, delivering approximately 2,400 nutritious meals to 175 homebound and self-isolating seniors each month. When the senior centers closed in March 2020 due to the pandemic, Meals on Wheels ramped up to accommodate seniors who depended on the Senior Community Meals as well as others who were in self-quarantine to minimize their exposure to COVID-19.

Mireille, a Lopez Island senior living on her own, recently shared how the Meals on Wheels program has impacted her life during the pandemic. "Prior to COVID-19, I used to attend the Wednesday and Friday lunches at the Lopez Senior Center on a regular basis. The social contact was so important and we seniors miss that a lot. However, Meals on Wheels has proved to be a real blessing. Over the past eleven months, not only have I been well-nourished, I have gained new friends."




The San Juan County Senior Nutrition Program provides home delivered "Meals on Wheels" and Senior Community Meals (currently on hold due to the pandemic) to older adults on Lopez, Orcas, and San Juan Islands. The Meals on Wheels and More program is administered by the non-profit Whatcom Council on Aging in partnership with San Juan County Senior Services and the senior centers on Lopez, Orcas and San Juan, which operate under the umbrella of the Senior Services Council of San Juan County 501(c)(3). The program is partially funded through federal grants, San Juan County levy funding, senior center in-kind contributions (utilities, fuel, kitchen equipment, etc.), and by client donations. The program also relies heavily on private donations and now, more than ever, we need your support to ensure we can continue to serve Mireille and all San Juan County seniors who need the meals during the pandemic and beyond!


